

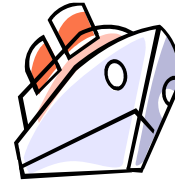


Career Exploration

The High School Guidance Office has several career exploration tools that are available to students and their families.

“**Do What You Are**” sponsored by **Bridges.com**. is a career assessment that can assist students in their Career Pathways choice and course selection. Students may use “Do What You Are” anytime provided they are a district resident, have internet access and funding remains available to continue its site license.

To access the assessment simply go to www.Achieveworks.com/16670. Click on “Register Here” and follow the prompts. The assessment takes about 40 minutes. Students may complete the assessment in one or more settings. Results are available for counselor review.



In addition we are pleased to announce the addition of “**CareerCruising**”. This career exploration site allows students to compare their likes and skills with careers that match their interests. Career cruising provides job descriptions, salary estimations and job availability projections for Berks County. Students can build a personal portfolio with career selections and available post secondary education opportunities. Results are available for counselor review.
